Abstract

The present study aimed to identify the problems facing the families of children with diabetes, and branching from this goal; The following sub-goals: identify the economic problems of families of children with diabetes, to identify the social problems of families of children with diabetes, to identify the psychological problems of families of children with diabetes, the second main goal: to identify the role of social service in Dealing with the families of diabetic children The researcher used the social survey method with the sample and it was applied to a sample of families of children with diabetes Hospital of Childbirth and Children in Najran during the study period from 1-9-1441 AH to 15/15/141 AH - where the study sample consisted of (59) individuals from the families of children with hospital of childbirth and children in Najran. For data analysis, use the statistical packages program (SPSS) and the study reached a number Among the most important results: the presence of many problems associated with psychological anxiety among parents of children with diabetes, that the social service has a role in modifying the relationship between healthy behavior and organic pain among patients, and the existence of a relationship between social service and acceptance of treatment in diabetics, and the most important recommendations: We recommend As specialists in the family, trying to balance as much as possible between caring for a diabetic and the rest of his siblings because the lack or lack of interest in the rest of the family may create a problem Social, we recommend that social workers do more in providing psychological support and guidance to the family and take advantage of the toll-free number 937, we recommend that the social worker definitely need to inform the families of children with diabetes that there are governmental and semi-governmental institutions that can benefit from their services, we definitely recommend that the social worker need to be informed Families of children with diabetes, with an application called (Nearby) that serves social and psychological counseling provided by the Ministry of Health.
